GRANTS TO INDIVIDUALS

Conditions

In 2007, The Rotary Club of Yeovil established a Charitable Trust known as the Yeovil Young Achievers Trust which is a charity number 1125247 Its object is to provide grants, equipment or other types of aid or assistance to young people living in Yeovil who, without added and outside help, would find it difficult to improve their skills and advance their qualifications and fulfil their potential.

These guidelines and conditions are for the assistance of any young person who wishes to apply for a grant from the Yeovil Young Achievers Trust.

Applications must be made in writing on the form attached and sent to:

Applications will be considered from young individuals who have shown ability and determination in overcoming personal difficulties and who positively demonstrate total and absolute commitment to improving their skills and fulfilling their potential.

The conditions are as follows but these may be added to or amended from time to time by the Trustees at their absolute discretion:-

1. A grant may be made by the Trust either in the form of funds or specialist equipment or training or in such other form as the Trustees in their absolute discretion consider.
2. The Trust is absolutely specific in that only Applicants who are resident in Yeovil (which is defined as Yeovil Town and Yeovil Without Parish) can be considered for support by the Trust.
3. Applications may be submitted at any time but will only be considered by the Trustees at their regular quarterly meetings.
4. No individual may submit more than one Application or be granted more than one grant but the Trustees at their discretion can make any grant payable by instalments.

5. Individuals are encouraged to be imaginative in their Applications and grants are not intended to provide incremental additions to school premises or equipment.
6. All Applications meeting the criteria of the Trust will be considered but there is no guarantee that financial assistance or any other assistance will be forthcoming and the awarding of grants is at the sole discretion of the Trustees.
7. Applicants may be required to attend for interview or respond to further questions raised by the Trustees.
8. The Trustees at their discretion may make further enquiries with regard to any Application.
9. Only the Trustees can decide the extent of any support provided which may be less than the amount applied for.
10. All recipients of grants will be required to provide feedback and reports to the Trustees demonstrating correct use of funds or equipment provided and grants may be made which are conditional.
11. All Applicants will be advised of the Trustees' decision in relation to claims that an individual has made.
12. The Trustees may at their discretion contact schools or other educational or professional authorities in connection with an Application and the Applicant's needs.
13. The Trustees reserve the right to monitor any grants made to satisfy themselves that the grant is being properly utilised in connection with the terms of the grant.
14. If it transpires that the grant is not being properly utilised in connection with the terms of the grant then the Trustees may in their absolute discretion withhold any unpaid instalment.
15. By signing these Conditions the recipient acknowledges that the Trustees may publicise the grant in such form as the Trustees reasonably require and at the Trustees' discretion. If however the recipient shows good reason to the Trustees why there should be no publicity attached to the grant the Trustees will bear such request in mind.

Notes

1. The Trustees are obliged to act in accordance with the provisions of the law on charities, the requirements of the Charity Commissioners and the Trustees.
